Please know that your safety and the safety of our staff is our utmost priority right now. So that everyone can enjoy the library in a safe manner, the following policies are currently in effect.

The library will continue to require that all staff and visitors wear masks inside the library buildings.

The library is committed to maintaining a safe environment for our staff and library users. The library's resources are used by a number of vulnerable populations including children, the elderly, and those with health conditions that leave them particularly vulnerable to COVID. In order to ensure that the library remains safe, welcoming, and accessible for everyone, we will continue to require that all staff and visitors wear properly-fitting masks that cover the nose and mouth while inside the library.

- Computers are available for only one hour per day per person. There will be no time extensions. Don't forget your library card! Limited computer assistance is available, from a safe distance.
- We may be limiting the amount of patrons allowed inside the library at any one time. Time limits will vary by branch.
- The water fountain is currently inaccessible.
- Meeting rooms and quiet rooms are currently unavailable.
- All winter programming will begin on January 10th virtually, but may be shifted to hybrid programming as it becomes safer to do so. Please continue to enjoy our virtual programming and databases!
- Museum passes are not currently available.
